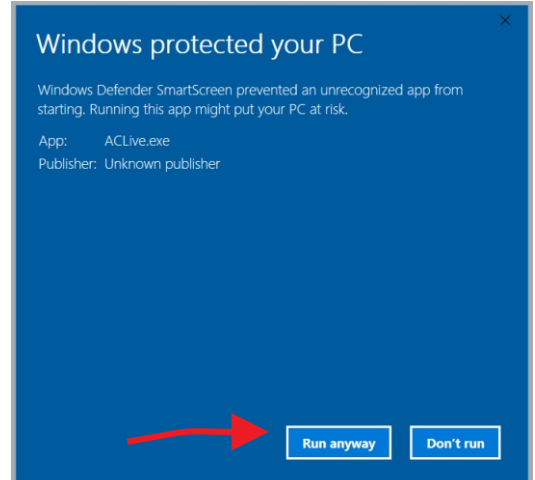


Set Up Automatic Texting to Your Cell Phone

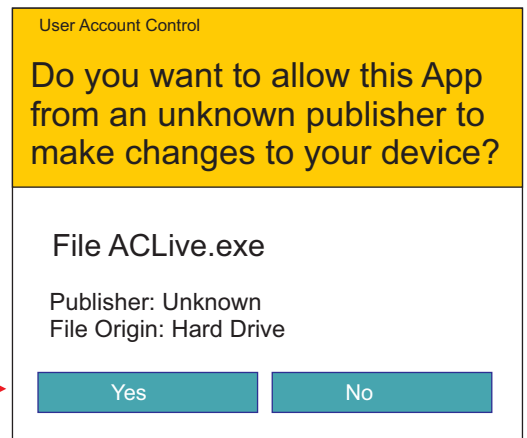
Requirements (your PC sends a text via email):
Internet Access
Cell Service
Windows 7, 8, 10 (Vista and XP NOT supported)
Merlin 8.0 or later

Connect your Weatherstation to your PC and Launch Merlin

Click Tools > ACLive
Click More Info
Click Run Anyway



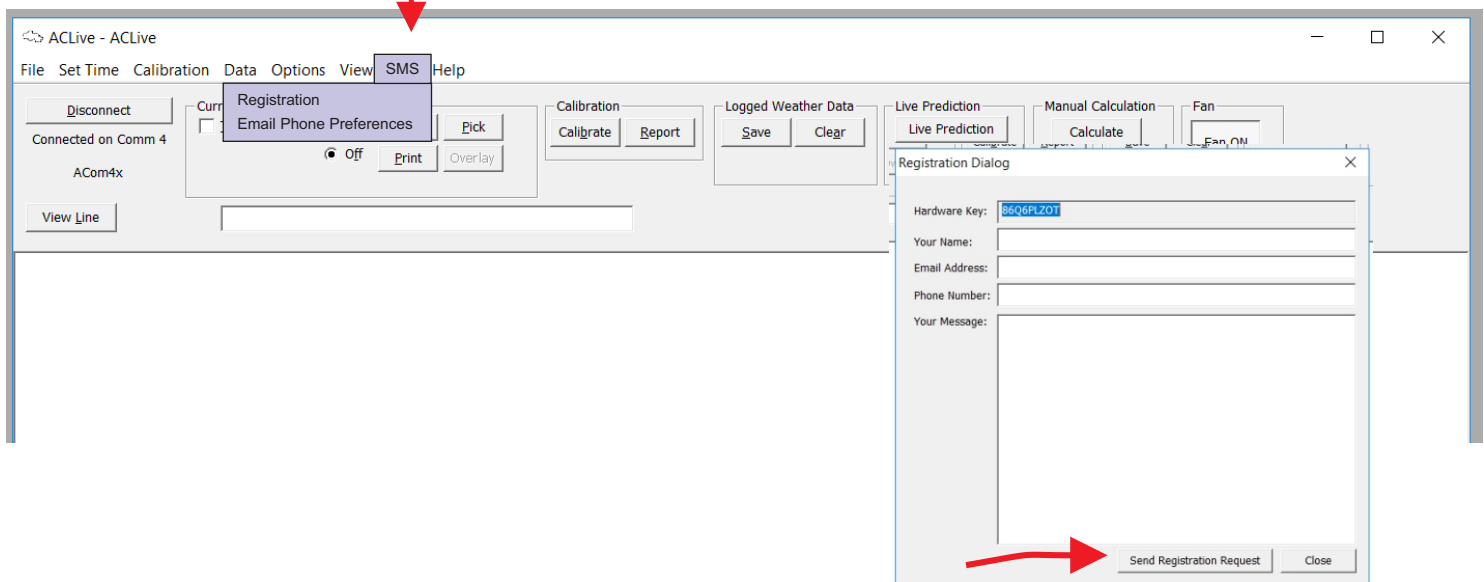
When the User Account Control Window opens Click Yes to allow ACLive to run.



Register for SMS

Hover over SMS and Click Registration
(first time on this PC only)

Enter your correct details and
Click Send Registration Request (message optional).



You will receive an email with your license file attached. Follow email directions to complete registration. If you change computers you will need to register again from the new device.

Hover over SMS
Click Email and Phone Preferences.
Fill out the dialog box.

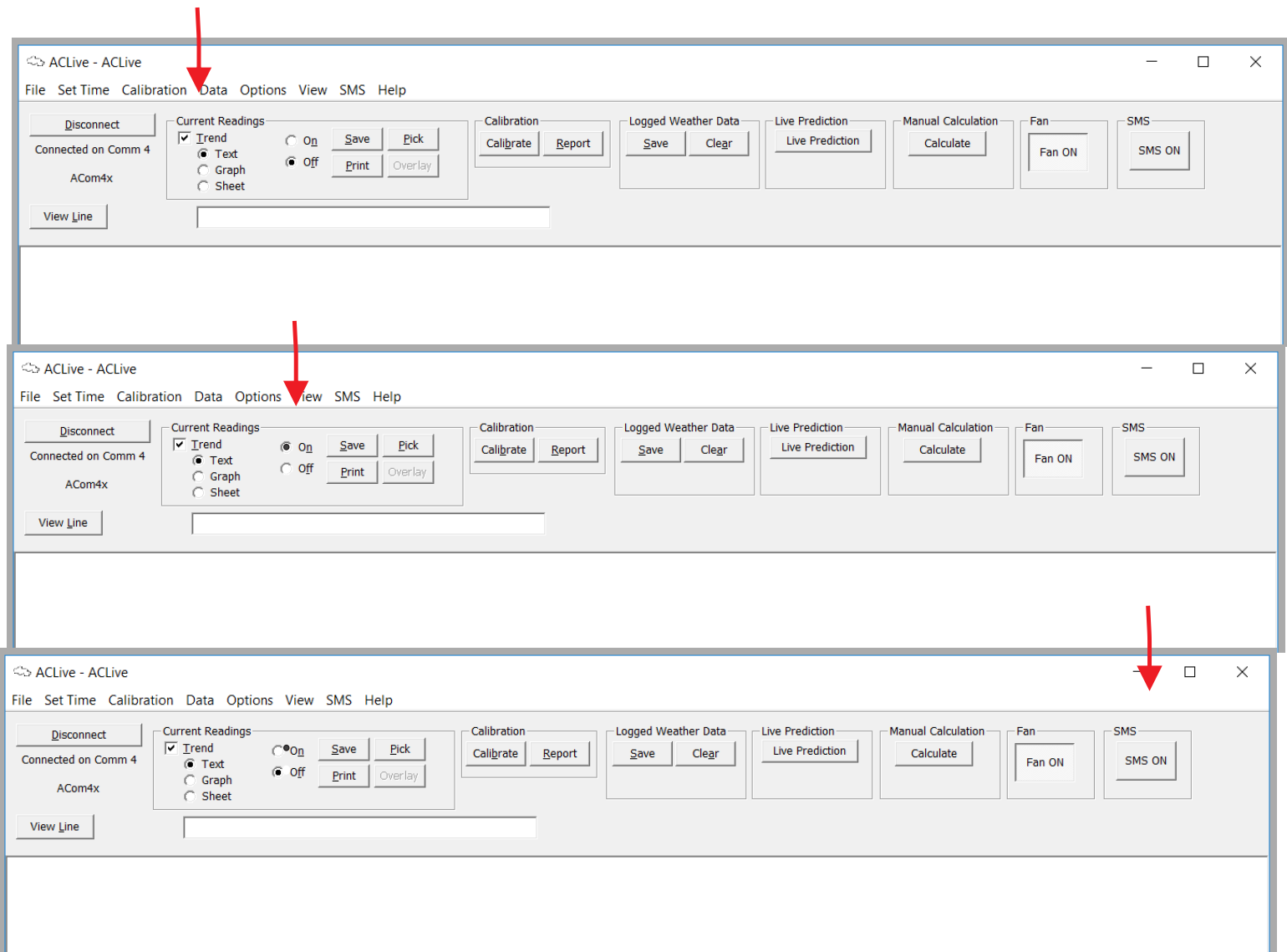
